

Dana Roeser, Bio (May 2019)

Dana Roeser's fourth book, *All Transparent Things Need Thundershirts*, won the Wilder Prize at Two Sylvias Press and will be published in September 2019. *The Theme of Tonight's Party Has Been Changed* was published in 2014 by the University of Massachusetts Press as winner of the Juniper Prize. It was named by Library Journal as one of "Thirty Amazing Poetry Titles for Spring 2014," by Baltimore City Paper in the "Top Ten Poetry of 2014," and as a 2014 IndieFab Book of the Year Award Finalist. *In the Truth Room* (2008, University Press of New England/Northeastern Univ. Press) and *Beautiful Motion* (2004, UPNE/Northeastern University Press) both won the Samuel French Morse Poetry Prize, in competitions judged by Rodney Jones and Ellen Bryant Voigt, respectively. For *Beautiful Motion*, Roeser was awarded The Great Lakes Colleges Association New Writers Award and the Jenny McKean Moore Writer-in-Washington Fellowship; *In the Truth Room* was nominated for the 2010 Poets' Prize. Roeser received a fellowship from the National Endowment for the Arts in 2007. Her poems have appeared, or are forthcoming, in *Pushcart Prize XLIII*, *Poetry*, *Crazyhorse*, *Cimarron Review*, *Laurel Review*, *Notre Dame Review*, *Diode*, *Green Mountains Review*, *Florida Review*, *The Seneca Review*, *Southern Humanities Review*, *Denver Quarterly*, *The Iowa Review*, *Prairie Schooner*, *Sou'wester*, *Southern Review*, *Southwest Review*, *Mississippi Review*, *Verdad*, *Pleiades*, *Alaska Quarterly Review*, *Harvard Review*, *Michigan Quarterly Review*, *Antioch Review*, *Shenandoah*, *Indiana Review*, *Sou'wester*, *The Massachusetts Review*, *Poetry Daily*, *Verse Daily*, and other journals and anthologies. Residencies in the U.S. and abroad have included those at Yaddo, The Virginia Center for the Creative Arts, Ragdale, VCCA France, and the VCCA International Exchange Program in Malta.
